FACTS

Konrad Partners is pleased to announce the organization of the **8th edition** of its “*Arbitrators’ Quest – Konrad Partners’ Moot Court*”, which will take place on **13 May 2022**.

The Arbitrators’ Quest is an annual moot Court competition where participants compete in a mock trial setting before lawyers from the Konrad Partners’ International Arbitration Practice Group. The competition is open to students, graduates and young professionals with an interest in international arbitration. The finalists will be invited to participate in a simulated hearing which will be conducted as a remote hearing for this edition’s Arbitrators’ Quest.

The winner will receive a paid internship with our International Arbitration Practice Group in Vienna. Additionally, the three top-rated participants will be awarded a book prize kindly donated by Wolters Kluwer Legal & Regulatory, International Group.

AIM

International arbitration is a specialized field of law that requires not only expert knowledge but a mastery of written and oral advocacy skills.

By participating in the Moot, you will have a unique opportunity to gain first-hand practical experience in situations and matters typically arising in international arbitration disputes, with the help of our experienced arbitration practitioners.

FORMAT

The moot case is based on an international sales contract that involves issues and facts which commonly arise in an arbitration.

Who may apply: The competition is open to students, graduates and young professionals with an interest in international arbitration.

We expect you to be reasonably familiar with general arbitration procedures.

The selection process: We will select twelve participants based on their written applications, which are due by 28 February 2022 (*see more below*). In March 2022, selected candidates will be notified and provided with a case file as well as further instructions. Participants will be expected to prepare a written memorandum in support of a pre-assigned party to the dispute.

Oral arguments will be held in a remote hearing on 13 May 2022. The winner will be selected based on the quality and content of his or her application, written submission and oral arguments. **Konrad Partners will award the winner with a paid internship in Vienna as well as the costs of accommodation.**

APPLICATION

The Arbitrators' Quest is primarily aimed at students, graduates and young professionals with an interest in international arbitration.

Applications will be accepted through **28 February 2022**.

- A motivational letter describing why you are applying to participate in the Moot and the internship;
- A detailed curriculum vitae; and
- An academic paper on the following topic:

“Public policy exception to enforcement of foreign arbitral awards”

The participants are encouraged to examine this legal issue in their jurisdictions and compare it to the developments in international arbitral practice.

The length of the paper should range from 1000 to 1500 words (the word count does not include footnotes and references).

Papers are expected to meet international academic standards. Findings should be supported by references and footnotes.

The quality of your application, both in terms of substance and form, will be taken into account for the selection of participants and the overall evaluation of your performance during the Moot.

The finalists will be notified in March 2022.
